



Samsung S8 / Android Email Setup

These are instructions for setting up the Samsung S8 with Integral's email servers. The setup of other Android Phones may be similar.


Click the Settings Button on your phone and then click "Choose Cloud and accounts"




Select Accounts




Select Add account



Select Email




Enter your email account, password, and click Manual Setup



Choose your account type. In most cases you would use POP3, but you can also use IMAP.

POP downloads emails to your phone so that they are always available, even if you don't have an internet connection. It downloads messages all at once.

IMAP will synchronize the emails on both devices but you would always need an internet connection to see your emails. IMAP downloads messages as you look at them.



Enter your email address, and in username also enter your full your email address.

Change the incoming server to icmailbox.com






